



**TAX RETURN FILERS**

Complete this section if you and/or your parents filed a 2015 income tax return with the IRS. As part of verification, the Financial Aid Office is required to collect your official tax data, either through the FAFSA IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) or via an IRS Tax Return Transcript. A copy of your Tax Return (1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ) is *not* acceptable for verification purposes. You must complete one of the steps outlined in the chart below. **You and your parent(s) must attach a 2015 W2** (or equivalent form, such as an IRS 1099) for all income earned from work, even if you and/or your parents used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool or are attaching a Tax Return Transcript.

**Please Note:** The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) on the FAFSA. If you or your parent(s) have not already used the tool, go to [FAFSA.gov](http://FAFSA.gov), log in to the 2017-18 FAFSA record, select "Make FAFSA Corrections," and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. From there, follow the instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the IRS DRT to transfer 2015 IRS income tax information into the FAFSA. After uploading tax data, **please be sure to submit the FAFSA**. For electronic Tax Filers, it takes up to **two weeks** for IRS information to be available for the DRT; for paper Tax Filers, up to **two months**.

To obtain a **free 2015 Federal Tax Return Transcript** directly from the IRS – not a photocopy of your tax return, go to [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov) and click on the "Order a Return or Account Transcript" link, and request the "IRS tax return transcript". You will need your Social Security Number, date of birth, and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used when the 2015 IRS tax return was filed). Alternatively, you may call **1-800-908-9946** to obtain the form(s). It takes up to two weeks for IRS income information to be available for electronic IRS tax return filers, and up to eight weeks for paper IRS tax return filers.

### TAX RETURN NON FILERS

Complete this section if you and/or your parent(s) will not file and are not required to file a 2015 income tax return with the IRS, but earned income from work in 2015. More information about who is required to file can be found at [www.IRS.gov](http://www.IRS.gov). If you are required to file a return, but have not, you must file your return in order to be considered for Federal Student Aid.
