SECTION 4: FEDERAL LOAN CHANGE REQUEST

Our office will be able to process your request for cancellation if your Federal loan has not yet been disbursed or it has been 14 days or less from the date of notification of your right to cancel your loan. This notification is provided on your billing statement. This means that we will take your loan amount back and return funds to the lender for you. This will reduce your debt. The direct loan servicer should send you an updated statement showing the reduction. The return of loan funds will also show on NSLDS (National Student Loan Data System) at www.nslds.ed.gov. Since the direct loan servicer updates NSLDS, it will take about 90 days for the returned amount to show up there.

If it has been more than 14 dates from the date of notification of your right to cancel the loan, DO NOT SUBMIT THIS FORM. Instead, you will need to contact your lender/servicer regarding your loan repayment.
